The main way is to file a Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request. Warning - it will be hard to get unless you were on the list yourself. If you weren't you have to go through a process that proves it's in the public interest, for that information to be released. Something that would probably be hard to prove.

No identifying information will be released. The lists I got only had first names of everyone on it, their scores, and their status (veteran, non-veteran, etc.) And of course if they were hired or not.

If you ever do apply for a job out at Crane and think something funny might be going on. You can file your FOIA request from this webpage.
